## 1:1 Support

- Support finding your way around the housing and benefits system
- Support looking for a job or training etc.
- Emotional support
- Attending appointments with you
- Making difficult phone calls with you
- Help filling in confusing forms

## Food Parcels

You can access food parcels if you have just moved in & applied for benefits - Supporting you to survive till your first payment. **OR** you are in a tenancy but have had an unexpected expenditure and find yourself low on food.

We can supplement our food parcels with food bank vouchers if required.

## Kitchen Packs

Consists of all brand new items that you would need to be able to cook and keep your kitchen clean until your community support grant is processed.

Kitchen packs include a microwave and George Foreman style grill.



## Furniture Bank

When you get a home of your own it is unfurnished. We can help you apply for furniture grants, but the process can take up to 11 weeks.

We are able to give you furniture which has very kindly been donated to us by members of the public.



## Wash Packs

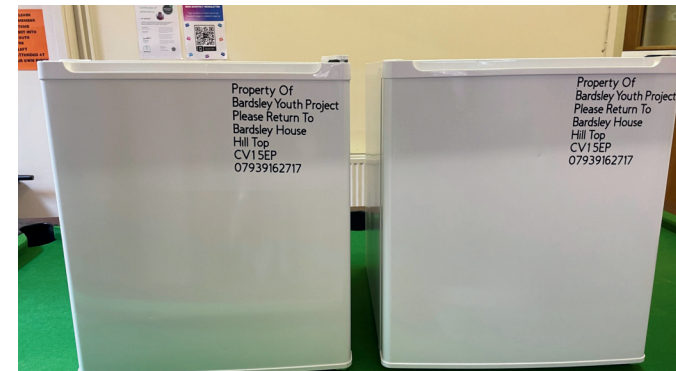
Contains essential items men and women need to keep themselves clean & take care of menstrual needs.

Designed to last you 6-8 weeks while you are waiting for initial benefits payments to come through.



## Loan Goods

For young people waiting on community grants to come through, but require a fridge, freezer or bed in the meantime.



## Clothes Bank

If you are short of clothes, we have a small clothes bank where you can come and get free clothing. Most of it has been kindly donated, but items such as underwear we buy new.
